Return in September


In September the children will return on Wednesday 4th September (new Reception children on Thursday 5th).

Swimming Lessons

What's been happening at WTW?

Last week was Mental Health Week. As part of this, many children took part in 'Wear it green' day to help raise awareness of mental health. Our Wellbeing Leaders ran a 'Wellbeing Café' in the playground where they provided activities for the children to join in as well as sharing uplifting and positive messages. This is something that they will be doing regularly, alongside many other great ideas they have for supporting and promoting positive wellbeing in our school.









Year 5 took part in Junior Roadwatch with the Metropolitan Police Transport Team. They learnt about the role of the police in keeping Londoners safe whilst travelling. As part of this, they used speed camera devices to track the speed of motorists on Kennington Road.





What's been happening at WTW?

Year 2 visited the temple Shri Swaminarayan Mandir in North London earlier this month. This visit linked to what they have been learning about Hinduism in RE.







Year 1 visited St James's Park where they used their scientific skills to identify the different variety of plants that make up the park. This trip linked to their topic this half term, 'In the Garden'. During the visit, the children also created Goldsworthy inspired art and observational drawings.

Year 6 completed their SATs last week. We are enormously proud of how hard they have worked in the run up to these tests and they definitely gave each test their absolute best.
